FUND OVERVIEW

Investment Objective

To generate capital growth over the medium to long-term period by investing in a balanced portfolio of investments and through re-investment of distribution, if any.

MARKET REVIEW

As at end November 2025, the fund reported an annualised return of 6.45%, over a 5-year basis, outperforming its benchmark's 1.85%

Global markets maintained their upward trend in November, with the FTSE All-World Index up 0.07%. Year-to-date, global markets have seen an overall positive performance of 21.79%. Europe was the best performing region in November, with the FTSE Europe Index climbed 1.52%. The highest performing country index for the month was FTSE Ireland Index at 9.99%. Conversely, the worst performing country index was the FTSE Saudi Arabia Index, finishing the month down at -8.55%. Malaysia's KLCI dropped by 4.68 index points during the month, registering a negative performance of -0.29% for the second consecutive month. Within the size segments of the FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index, KLCI was the best performer in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Index Series, overshadowing the poor performance of FTSE Bursa Malaysia Small Cap Index of -5.73%. The FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index dropped -0.89%. The top ten constituents of the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI account for 66.62% of the index, as compared to 46.55% for FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index and 20.24% for the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Small Cap Index. Financials was the best performing sector in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI Index, registering 2.62% with Industrials being the second-best performer at 0.29%. Conversely, Consumer Discretionary was the worst performing sector followed by Utilities, at -9.34% and -7.34% respectively. With an index weighting of 41.58% and 6 constituents, Financials is the largest industry in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI. This compares to a weight of 30.21% and 10 constituents in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index. Construction and Materials is the largest industry in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Small Cap with an index weighting of 15.25% and 24



Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 30 November 2025, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this Fund is 6.1 and is classified as "Low" (source: Novagni). "Low" includes funds with VF that are above 4.195 but not more than 7.805. The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
