

**FUND OVERVIEW**

**Investment Objective**

To generate a reasonable level of capital appreciation and income distribution to the unit holders by investing in a balanced portfolio of investments.

**Potential Investor**

ASN Imbang 3 Global is suitable for investors whom:

- Have moderate risk tolerance;
- Have a preference for income and liquidity;
- Have a preference to have investment with global exposure; and

**MARKET REVIEW**

As at end July 2024, the fund reported an annualised return of 1.85%, over a 3-year basis, underperforming its benchmark's 3.85% return.

Global markets continued its positive trend in July, with the FTSE All-World Index rising to 1.77%. Year-to-date, global markets have seen an overall positive performance of 13.27%. Middle East & Africa was the best performing region in July, with the FTSE Middle East & Africa Index rose 4.24%. The highest performing country index for the month was FTSE Ireland Index at 10.07%. Conversely, the worst performing country index was the FTSE Poland Index, finishing the month down at -5.32%. Malaysia's KLCI spiked by 35.48 index points during the month, registering a positive performance of 2.23%. Within the size segments of the FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index, FTSE Bursa Malaysia Mid 70 Index was the best performer in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Index Series, rising 3.62% for the month, overshadowing the poor performance of FTSE Bursa Malaysia Small Cap Index of 0.63%. The FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index soared 2.46%. The top ten constituents of the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI account for 64.36% of the index, as compared to 41.84% for FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index and 18.20% for the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Small Cap Index. Industrials was the best performing sector in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI Index, registering 6.14% with Consumer Discretionary being the second-best performer at 5.06%. Conversely, Materials was the worst performing sector followed by Utilities, at -7.23% and -1.40% respectively. With an index weighting of 39.49% and 6 constituents, Financials is the largest industry in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI. This compares to a weight of 28.10% and 11 constituents in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index. Industrial Goods & Services is the largest industry in the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Small Cap with an index weighting of 20.53% and 38 constituents.

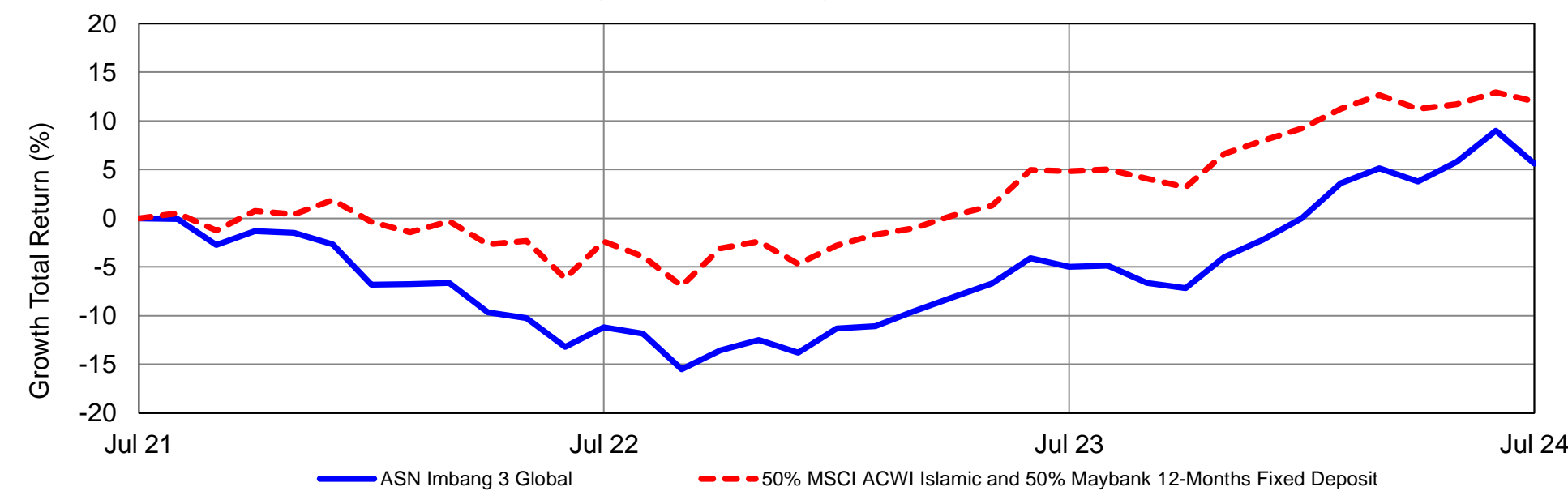

Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 31 July 2024, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this Fund is 7.6 and is classified as "Low" (source: Novagni). "Low" includes funds with VF that are above 4.785 but not more than 8.795. The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.

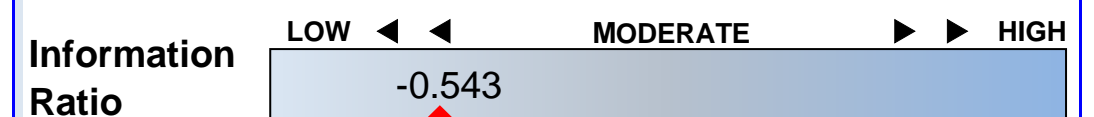
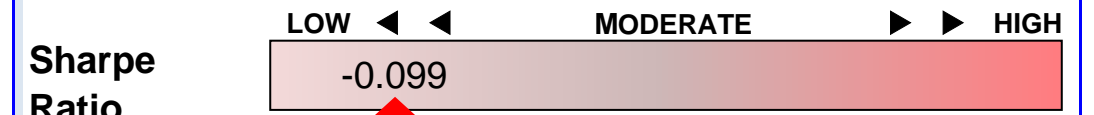
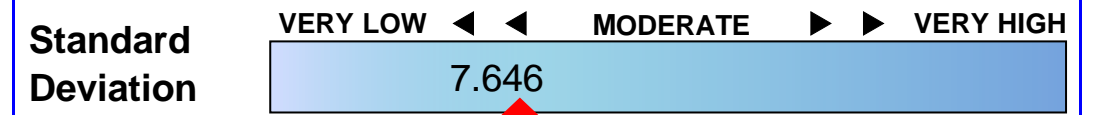
